## The Rule of Law

- An Inspector Calls considers the difference between criminal acts and immoral acts and how far the rule of law extends.
- Romeo and Juliet explores the relationship between acts of revenge, taking the law into our own hands.

## **Individual Liberty**

- All the literary texts we study look closely at the choices individuals make and the freedom that they have to act. Often these choices are moral, as in An Inspector Calls. Sometimes they are dilemmas within the constraints of a system, like Romeo and Juliet. They all explore the highest hopes of an individual, as well as the depths that humans can sink to through rash judgements and poor choices or being at odds with a regime.
- Literature obviously helps us to develop, explore, and express personal thoughts, beliefs, opinions and feelings. It is about our deepest hopes and fears.
- All bar one text we study is part of the literary heritage of Britain, from Shakespeare to modern poets like Simon Armitage, and the study of English explores the diversity and richness of these texts, as well as considering the ideas of the society at the time and the philosophical and artistic movements that inspired them.
