| Year 10 | <p><b><u>Unit 1 - Portfolio of work</u></b><br/> <b><u>Project: Self-Portrait/Life's Journey</u></b></p> <p>Students will explore the theme of Identity/life's Journey, reflecting on a range of artists. This unit will explore observational drawing, photography, photomontage, 3D relief, printmaking and sculpture. The final composition will link directly with sketchbook work and have a clear link to the chosen artist/s. This will be an opportunity for students to explore their own personal response this particular theme.</p> |          |   |          | <p><b><u>Unit 2 - Portfolio of work</u></b><br/> <b><u>Project: Food and Drink</u></b></p> <p>Produce a selection of work, thoughtfully presented in sketchbooks in a variety of 2D,3D and mixed media under the working title of Food and Drink.</p> <p>Students will have task lists including observation drawings, photography, painting, sculpture, developmental work which explores a personal response to issues raised. | Year 11 | <p><b><u>Unit 1</u></b></p> <p>New project development from practice exam paper (or continue with project 2). To include all of that mentioned in project 1 or a personal project of students' choice. A <b>mock exam</b> will take place at the end of this term.</p>  |          | <p><b><u>Unit 2 - Externally set task (40%)</u></b></p> <p>Exam task is released and given out in January 2021. Students will select one starting point from the paper to develop a project where their final response is created under exam conditions (10 hours).
